THE QUEENSLAND RESOURCES COUNCIL (QRC) JUNIOR RESOURCES AWARD FOR WOMEN AIMS TO ENCOURAGE YOUNG WOMEN TO CONSIDER CAREERS IN THE MINERALS AND ENERGY SECTORS.

### AWARDS

This category of the QRC's Resources Award for Women is presented annually at the QRC's International Women's Day breakfast held in Brisbane.

The awards aim to increase the profile of women working in the sector, provide them with a flagship networking opportunity and promote the sector as an exciting career option for women.

The junior award is judged on the basis of candidates' strong demonstrated interest in a career in the resources sector and their ability to be an ambassador for the sector. It is available only to students of Queensland Minerals and Energy Academy schools.

**To be eligible students must be entering year 12 in 2012.**

All expenses paid trip to Brisbane for winner and guardian (if living in regional area).

Special guest at the QRC's International Women's Day breakfast.

Opportunity to network with leading women in the resources sector.

Be an ambassador for the resources sector.

A cash prize of \$200, a trophy and framed certificate.
